Dear User,

Thank you for your cooperation.

this brief guide presents the main rules for correct separate waste collection in the Argenta municipality. Please read this brochure and preserve it for future reference if you have any doubts about where to throw an item, ranging from the most common to a very particular one. Residents in our municipality have adopted the separate waste collection system for more than 20 years. Each year we introduce new materials that can be sent for recovery. Indeed, today, almost all the waste produced in our homes can be collected separately and recovered. Together we can keep our area clean and hospitable.

general waste





A "chute" system to limit the volume of waste delivered

Since the chute was installed in the lid of the grey street bin for general waste, residents can only deliver bags with maximum volume 20-22 L. The limited volume further encourages separate waste collection, preventing people from throwing into general waste any materials that can, instead, be sent for recovery, such as cardboard, green and bulky waste.

GENERAL WASTF

Only a minor part of the waste we produce cannot be sorted. The following is a rough list of items that can be thrown into the street bin equipped with chute.

HOW does the chute bin work

The chute is easy to use, and allows you to insert waste in bags up to 20-22 L



OPEN THE CHUTE rotate the lever forward



INSERT THE BAG ensure that it is firmly closed



CLOSE THE CHUTE rotate the lever in the opposite direction



THIS SYSTEM ALLOWS YOU TO:

- stop delivery of bulky waste, such as cardboard and green waste;
- deliver waste 24 hours a day, 7 days a week;
- considerably limit delivery by residents of neighbouring municipalities.

paper, cardboard and Tetra Pak

- Magazines, newspapers, dailies
- Photocopies and used paper
- FOLDED cardboard and boxes
- EMPTY Tetra Pak packages for milk, wine, fruit juice and foodstuffs
- Boxes for pasta and foodstuffs
- Sugar and flour bags
- Napkins and tissues that are NEITHER dirty NOR greasy
- Bags for foodstuffs
- Cardboard containers for eggs





Bin collection frequency: twice a week





- Aluminium-lined paper
- Baking paper
- Wallpaper
- Plasticated paper
- Dirty paper (e.g., greasy cardboard)
- Tinfoil











Tetra Pak packages are entirely recyclable. The three components, 75% paper, 20% polyethylene and 5% aluminium, are entirely recovered to produce new paper and new plastic material. Look for the Tetra Pak symbol, and throw the appropriately rinsed and crushed package into the blue

street bin for paper collection.





- EMPTY bottles for beverages and oil
- Bags and shopping bags, even biodegradable
- NON GREASY plastic dishes
- CLEAN yoghurt and cheese containers
- EMPTY AND CLEAN bottles and containers of house cleaning and personal hygiene products
- Containers for eggs, cured meats, fresh pasta and vegetables
- Plastic crates
- All polystyrene items, food trays and miscellaneous packaging





Bin collection frequency: twice a week





- All multi-material objects (e.g. with metal parts)
- Hard plastic items, garden furnishings, roller shutters, flowerpots, large toys
- Rubber items, footwear, plastic and latex gloves















glass, cans and tins

- EMPTY bottles, glasses and glass jars
- Aluminium cans and bottles for beverages
- Aluminium and steel cans and jars for preserves (meat, fish, tomatoes, legumes, oil, etc.)
- Aluminium caps, steel crown caps, jar covers
- Spray cans (gas-free deodorant spray, whipped cream, etc.)
- Metal clothes hangers
- Tinfoil, aluminium sheets and food trays





Bin collection frequency: weekly





FALSE FRIENDS

organic waste in the composter

- Organic cooking waste, leftover food (bread, pasta, etc.)
- Fruit and vegetable waste
- Coffee grounds and coffee pods (pods must be disposed of as general waste)
- Tea bags without the thread
- Used napkins, serviettes and paper tissues (not coloured/printed)
- Non-printed pieces of paper and cardboard
- Egg shells
- Flowers, leaves and dry plants
- Small amounts of branches and chopped wooden materials (even cork stoppers)
- Small amounts of completely cooled wood ash

organic waste, tracked collection

ALL COOKING WASTE

You can place all cooking waste in the brown street bins for organic waste, **even meat and fish waste**, including small bones and fish bones, mollusc shells, greasy waste, dairy products and small packaging made of compostable material, such as torn shopping bags.







Street BINS



- Diapers and incontinence pads
- Weeds or sick plants
- No type of liquid (cooking oil must be collected separately, see page 15)





SOELIA provides a kit including a personal card with identification code to open street bins and record any waste delivery, a bin for daily waste collection at home, and the related biodegradable bags.

Compostable bags for organic waste can be collected on Thursdays at the customer counter in via Vianelli 1 in Argenta.

The baas for the collection of green waste can be collected on Thursdays at the customer counter in Via Vianelli 1 in Argenta.

Place the firmly closed bags and tied bundles of twigs outside the house on the evening before the dedicated waste collection. New bags will be left for you, free of charge, when the filled ones are collected. Operators are not authorised to collect non-compliant green waste. For large quantities, the material must be directly delivered by the resident to the Waste Recovery Centre in via Bandissolo.

waste cooking oil

- Frying oil
- Pickle oil (e.g. artichokes, mushrooms, olives, etc.)
- Canned fish oil (e.g. tuna fish, mackerel, etc.)
- Saturated fats (pork fat, lard, butter)

ALWAYS FILTER THE OIL USING THE FUNNEL

Discharging oil into the sewer system is very damaging: it clogs the household sewer system and generates volatile foam in sewage treatment systems. 1 kg of oil dispersed in water forms a layer of film as large as a football field.

Bulky waste and sanitaryware collection is **FREE OF CHARGE THROUGHOUT THE MUNICIPALITY**. Hence, it is absolutely illogical to leave bulky waste in streets or near the street bins.

The day and method of collection will be agreed on with the operators. Bulky materials must be placed in an accessible place outside the property.

RUP items can also be delivered if they are not entirely empty, but ensure that the packages are intact to avoid leakage of the contents.

fabrics and clothes

- Clothes, knitwear, trousers, jeans, jackets and coats
- Linens
- Accessories, hats, bags, belts, gloves, shoes in pairs
- Blankets and sheets
- Toys
- Table clothes and fabrics of all types
- Carpets and curtains

Close the clothes in small bags, separated from shoes and accessories. Material in a good condition is sanitised and taken to centres for the needy. The remaining material is processed and transformed into industrial and building construction materials.

the waste recovery centre in Via Bandissolo dismantling bulky waste

In via Bandissolo, Argenta, there is a dismantling centre for bulky waste collected in our municipality. The facility, established in 2010 by SOELIA with the contribution of the Emilia-Romagna Regional Administration and of the Ferrara Provincial Administration, is managed by Cooperativa Sociale La Pieve, which is also in charge of collecting green waste and bulky waste. This is where the various waste types are differentiated and recovered by dismantling bulky waste, particularly: wool, fabrics, wood, iron and glass.

The Separate Waste Collection Centre in via Bandissolo **for companies**

All companies in the Argenta municipality can deliver materials and special waste to the equipped separate waste collection centre in via Bandissolo. The collection centre is authorised to collect waste with various CER (European waste codes) codes. Deliveries must always be accompanied by the appropriately completed waste identification form.

Farms

The following materials can be delivered free of charge without daily limitations:

Code 130208 waste oil;

Code 150202 filters;

Code 160601 batteries from farm machinery.

At the same conditions, plastic packaging, such as, for instance, bags of seeds and fertilisers (code 150102) are collected free of charge.

The form is not required for urban waste directly delivered by residents, and waste collection is always free of charge, with the exception of green waste: for deliveries in excess of 300 kg, a cost of € 45 per tonne will be applied to the overall quantity.

DISMANTLING AND COLLECTION ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PUBLIC URBAN HYGIENE SERVICE, WHICH IS FREE OF CHARGE FOR USERS.

To request a survey, leave your data, the name of the building's owner and the address (the service is only available for buildings in the Argenta municipality). Waste collection cannot be fractionated, e.g., if a resident has to remove a 30 m2 roof, the service will be entirely charged to him (not 24 m2 to the public service and 6 m2 to the resident).

The actual time required to perform the work can range from 45 to 60 days from submission of the request.

eco-friendly tips!

REDUCE WASTE PRODUCTION AT THE ORIGIN

- You can do this by carefully choosing WHAT to purchase and HOW to purchase it
- · It is a **DUTY** of every responsible resident

• It is much more **CONVENIENT** and environmentally friendly than investing in improving disposal methods

AT THE SUPERMARKET

- · Do not purchase disposable products.
- Prefer lasting and rechargeable solutions, such as detergents in bulk.
- Choose products that have the least amount of packaging, and which are possibly made of a single material.
- Prefer seasonal foods and fresh foods sold over the counter, compared to those in trays. If you can, choose KMO foods to reduce pollution caused by transport, and to promote local produce.
- · Use a cotton fabric bag or a bag made of more lasting and resistant material, instead of a disposable bag.
- Encourage the recycled products market with your purchases.
- Look for the **ECOLABEL** brand: toilet paper and paper tissues, detergents, paper for photocopies.

EMPTY AND CRUSH

Before you throw a container, empty it and reduce the volume as much as possible by folding cardboard.

Separate waste collection is the duty of the resident, but it is also an obligation established by the law and by the Regulation for Peaceful Coexistence, Safety and Quality of Life adopted by the Argenta municipality.
